

2017 Treatment and Alternatives and Diversion (TAD) Competitive Funding Round Timeline

February 22, 2016	Send preliminary communication and distribute a survey to all counties and tribes in Wisconsin to gauge current county infrastructure and programming capacity (e.g., established CJCC, existing partnerships, treatment court/diversion programs, etc.).
April 1, 2016	A draft competitive TAD grant announcement is completed.
April 1 – April 30, 2016	Regional TAD grant writing trainings will be held around the state. The trainings will be open to all counties and tribes and will be based on the criteria detailed in the draft grant announcement.
May 1, 2016	The TAD grant announcement will be released to all counties and tribes statewide.
June 30, 2016	TAD applications are due in DOJ's Egrants system.
July – August, 2016	TAD applications are reviewed by a peer review panel developed by DOJ. Applications will be scored based on the criteria established in the grant announcement and discussed at the grant writing trainings.
September 1, 2016	Grant awards and funding decisions are announced.
January 1, 2017	New TAD project period begins.
Spring 2017	Regional Treatment Court Standards Trainings and trainings regarding pretrial diversion programs are delivered to programs statewide.
