Welcome

The meeting began at 12:16 p.m. Secretary Jared Hoy welcomed members to the meeting. Quorum was present.

November 12, 2025, Meeting Minutes

Secretary Hoy requested a motion to approve November 12, 2025, meeting minutes.

Review March 11, 2026, CJCC Agenda DRAFT

Ryan Anderson reviewed the Items on the March 11, 2026, agenda.

Secretary Hoy reported that the Governor's office and DOC are working with the legislature on the DOC's broader landscape realignment plan and Secretary Hoy may provide more information in the legislative wrap up section of the March meeting.

Anderson will also reach out to the other state agencies for their federal grant information.

Connie Kostelac requested an item for a future meeting. Kostelac suggested a presentation on the Wisconsin Community Safety Fund. The fund awarded \$10.4 million to 10 communities across the state, focusing on safety priorities such as suicide, domestic violence, and community violence. Secretary Hoy appreciated the suggestion and asked DOJ Staff to add it to a future meeting agenda.

Secretary Hoy asked the subcommittee if there are any announcements to share.

Attorney General Kaul updated the subcommittee on the letter that was approved by the CJCC at the December meeting, regarding the CJCC's support of the elimination of court authority to order Failure to Pay Forfeiture/Failure to Pay Juvenile Forfeiture driver's license suspensions. AG Kaul said the CJCC's position has been communicated with the Governor and now the letter can be sent to the legislature. DOJ Staff will update the letter and deliver electronically to the legislature.
