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## Welcome

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The meeting began at 12:15 p.m. Attorney General Kaul welcomed members to the meeting. Quorum was present.

Attorney General Kaul asked if anyone had any announcements. Ryan Anderson, DOJ Staff, announced meeting protocol procedures.

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## May 14, 2025, Meeting Minutes

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AG Kaul requested a motion to approve the May 14, 2025, meeting minutes.

Motion was made by Kelli Thompson and seconded by Judge Jon Richards to approve the Executive Subcommittee May 14, 2025, meeting minutes.

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## Review September 10, 2025, CJCC Agenda DRAFT

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Ryan Anderson reviewed the September 10, 2025, agenda items. Anderson reported he will announce meeting protocols at the start of the September CJCC meeting.

Secretary Hoy asked for a typo correction. Correction was made.

Judge Richards noted that the Race Equity, Inclusion and Access Subcommittee is working on a position statement to support the elimination of driver's license suspension as a debt collection method for failure to pay forfeiture. He

requested that the topic be added to the December 2025 CJCC meeting agenda. Judge Richards also reported the subcommittee continues their work on increasing juror compensation.

AG Kaul asked for additional information regarding the presentation on DOC Strategic Priorities. Secretary Hoy responded the DOC recently updated their strategic priorities. The four priorities are Safety, Wellness, Collaboration, and Consistency. The DOC Deputy Secretary will be presenting about these priorities at the September 10 CJCC meeting.

AG Kaul is interested in long term prison capacity plans. Secretary Hoy agrees the prison discussion would be beneficial and would hope to have that information available after more review of the state budget.

Ashley Billig reported the Data Sharing/Outcomes, Trends and Indicators Subcommittee presentation will include agency data projects and an update on a few goals that the subcommittee has been working towards with assistance from small workgroups.

Kelli Thompson acknowledged the retirement of Lisa Yeates, the DOC Regional Chief, Division of Community Corrections. Yeates was a member of the Treatment Alternatives and Diversion Subcommittee and Thompson thanked her for her good work on the subcommittee. Thompson reported that Dr. Melissa Parrent, Psychologist Manager in the Division of Community Corrections, has been appointed and the subcommittee knows she will be a valuable addition.
