Demographic Data Survey Discussion

Demographic Data Survey Discussion

Connie Kostelac reported on the Demographic Data Survey that will be sent out to the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police and Badger State Sheriffs Associations. The survey is designed to capture a better picture of where the data comes from. The survey will be placed on SharePoint for the last revisions. Kostelac hopes to have some of the survey results completed for the next CJCC meeting on September 8th.

Lashua discussed the jail data in Milwaukee and updated the subcommittee on TraCS and citation data. Race and ethnicity are not separated in the system. It is captured when it comes into TraCS but is overwritten. Brenda Ray reported TraCS doesn't have separate race and ethnicity, Milwaukee just takes it in and changes it from initial entry. The data needs to be consistent at every level.

Justice Reinvestment Initiative (JRI) Update

Veitenheimer provided an update. The position within DOJ has been approved and a hire has been made. The new hire will start August 15th. He will be attending the Data Sharing subcommittee meetings moving forward.

Data Sharing Agreement Template Update

Megan Jones has submitted the template for review and feedback. Milda Aksamitauskas is waiting for DOJ's Division of Legal Services to review. They are both expecting feedback before the August meeting.

Indicator Development

Kostelac will send out a draft for review. Kostelac is looking for key items to measure and any questions members may have. Kostelac is hopeful to have a draft sent out before the next meeting.

Kostelac reported on the increase in violent crimes and homicides, in not only Milwaukee, but across the state in the past year. Discussion centered on the following topics:
