Welcome and Opening Comments

Approval of January 20, 2026 Meeting Minutes

Motion to approve the minutes began with Tyler Brandt and seconded by Ashley Billig.

Agency Updates

- **Courts- Tyler Brandt**
 - New deputy director and office manager
 - Considering moving Tyler's team to cloud-based system over next year
 - Probably Microsoft
 - More cost effective
 - Preparing for budget
- **DOT- Dave Harvey**
 - Moved off pilot phase of law enforcement agencies sharing with Traffic Operations and Safety (TOPS) lab
 - 118 contributing agencies as of now
 - Showed heat map example
 - Question from Chris Henning: Can colors change based on agency to see where there may be overlap between agencies?
 - Answer from Dave: that functionality does not currently exist but could be useful

- Overview of phase 1 of Pursuit dashboard
 - Phase 2 in planning stage
- Showed shared platform state patrol and other agencies use for water over roadways
 - Exporting data to DOT so they can make changes if possible
- Pipeline work going on in northern WI
 - Brings in a lot of different agencies, have used similar maps as shown to help coordinate
- **DAIT- Brenda Ray**
 - Moved cloud-based e-referral interface
 - Rolling out web-based e-signature
 - Complete overhaul of intercounty query operation, allows district attorney (DA) offices to get better view of person based on state ID
 - One year left on project, rolling things out at different times
 - Receiving questions on why DAIT provides tech support to counties
 - New director reaching out to CCAP on issue
- **DOJ- Ashley Billig**
 - Sent out law enforcement request to submit 2025 search warrant data
 - Last year for survey. Reporting now in TraCS
 - Report due July 2026
 - Accessibility compliance work happening
 - Amazon Web Services (AWS): Testing new roles and connections to address some issues
 - Race and Equity Subcommittee: lack of attorneys available, so may do some data work to assist
 - Statute tables: need to update with new statutes and UCR offense codes, almost complete
 - Use of Force and Arrest-Related Deaths (UFAD) dashboard: internally discussing separating them out so it is clearer as to what is use of force vs arrest related deaths
 - New data collection supervisor – Erica Beckman, started mid-March
- **DWD- Ellie Hartman and Bryan Huebsch**
 - Follow up study on reemployment services will be about spill over
 - DOC study on prisoner education outcomes
 - Free training opportunity through Coleridge: prison education, registration due April 24: <https://coleridge.us/events/pepadacourse>
 - Data management guidance available now
 - Workforce data quality grant
 - Enhance training providers and data
 - Integrate Credential Transparency Description Language (CTDL)
 - Attending conference in DC: <https://iris.isr.umich.edu/tip/>
 - identifying new technology and integrating with unemployment data

- finishing workforce innovation grant- training, childcare, transportation
- finishing workforce advancement initiative grant- wrap around case management and support services

- **DHS- Laura Ninneman and Caitlin Murphy**
 - Data modernization update:
 - Submitted meta data tool (Collibra) contract
 - Security command center show and tell this week
 - Data request tracking system getting final approval soon-within next week or so
 - Act 181 work transitioning to DHS shortly for the opioid and meth data portal
 - Requires annual report to Joint Finance Committee (JFC)
 - 2025 report won't be done for some time yet
 - Everything in report is public already
- **MCW – Connie Kostelac**
 - Working on setting up pilot agencies for place of last drink
 - Some funding for more pursuit work in Milwaukee County
- **DOC - NA**

ADA Compliance Update

- Timeline extended a year
- DOJ: some Tableau and some PBI dashboards
 - First approach: make sure there is downloadable data file of raw data of what is displayed
 - For Power BI: found a tool to help with color contrast, alt text, tab order
- DHS: creating plans for remediation; struggling with guidance, especially with web applications
- DWD: have been using screen readers and doing agency trainings for years
- DOC: have guidelines put together; starting to work on updating dashboards; have been hosting through Tableau public and want to switch to server and learned that there is ADA compliance functionality in server; have not received much guidance either; recently hired someone specifically for ADA compliance in tech division

2026 Goal Updates and Next Steps

- Added specificity and status updates to goals document
- JRI 19 project
 - Report on what warehouse allows for, with performance indicators
 - Main indicator: being able to look beginning to end
 - Overview of draft dashboard
 - Sankey diagram starting with arrest charge
- Document process of linking data across systems, will send out message about group for this

- Update demographic report- review before July meeting
- Map criminal justice data against sequential intercept model (SIM)
- Outreach to other subcommittees

Demographic Data Discussion

- Map of demographic data collection at criminal justice decision points
 - Add UFAD and deflection programs
 - How about employee demographic data? Possible future project
 - Ellie: DWD has done some of this

- Bryan- DWD working to gain training as policies require training component – Innovate U.S. - <https://innovate-us.org/>
- Laura- DHS has DOA approved AI policy; trying to come up with use cases before submitting forms
- Connie- MCW dealing with it for students and faculty both; working on generative AI within firewall
- Ask Brian Kreklau (DET Bureau of Technical Architecture) to come to upcoming meeting
