## AGENDA TOPICS

### Approval of Meeting Minutes

A motion to approve the 1.10.20 meeting minutes was made by Megan Jones and seconded by Derek Veitenheimer. The motion was approved.

### Jail Data Overview and Discussion

A presentation on APPRISS, a program that runs the VINE (Victim Information Notification Everyday) program, was given by APPRISS representative Tiffany Massey. APPRISS interfaces with all county jails for booking information.

- The subcommittee discussed how jail movement data remains a gap statewide.
  - One main issue is how raw data can't be funneled back to the state/counties.
- There was a general discussion on what data would be valuable from the jails, there was consensus that there should be more data throughout the points in the system (pretrial, re-arrest, prison, etc.)

### March 2020 Report

The subcommittee provided feedback on the draft of the Data Sharing report, some suggestions included:

- Exploring how criminal justice data relates to other non-criminal justice data
  - (DHS, DCF, Overdose Deaths)
- Grouping focus areas into larger overarching headings
- Removing 2020 and focusing more on long term focus/recommendations
- Consideration of a statewide data catalog
- Additional dedicated data scientists/analysts and resources
- There was a discussion on the process of creating MOU's for data sharing and how this subcommittee should be the governing body of the data procured.
- Lack of resources (analysts, etc.) available for data sharing remains an issue for continued discussion.
